
That's what victory is, in our minds. Not winning, necessarily. But doing. And enjoying.








MAIN CHARITY PARTNER FOR ADIDAS WOMEN'S RACE 5 KM

Kenyan Henry Kiplagat dominated in the center of Prague during the Grand Prix. The 10-kilometer race in the center of Prague was won by a 19-year-old Kenyan runner, who was second in the march Prague half-marathon. He crossed the finish line on Old Town Square in a time of 27:51, which was 17 seconds behind last year's record of his compatriot Philemon Lim.




Kenya's Geoffrey Ronoh again dusted the field, dramatically outdueling compatriot Geoffrey Mutai down the stretch on Na Přikopě Street to triumph in a race-record time of 27:28. Mutai. of course, has been called the world's fastest marathoner after winning Boston marathon in the world best time.

The 22nd Grand Prix was broadcast live on ČT Sport and on ivysilani.cz. The race was awarded with the International Association of Athletics Federation IAAF Gold Quality for the fourth time in a row. Seven races of the RunCzech Running League have a total of seven gold quality marks, which moves the Czech Republic to the top of the global ranking of countries organizing long - distance races. 
